

Camp Full Moon Farm

The FMF Camp day is filled with horse-related everything! Campers will enjoy daily riding, horse care and horse related crafts and games. Riding groups are formed by age and previous riding experience to let everyone get the most from their daily lessons. Ample assistance is provided for “new horse people”. Campers who have not previously ridden independently may enjoy their camp riding experience more if they have completed a few private lessons before camp begins but it is not required.

Camp Schedule

Camp begins promptly at 9 am each day. Please plan to arrive a few minutes in advance to walk your camper up to registration and sign them in each day.

Our day ends at 3 pm and we ask that each camper be signed out at the end of each day.

For a fee, Before and Aftercare can be arranged in advance from 7:30 am to 5 pm (with no aftercare on Friday.)

We tailor each day based on the campers’ interests and abilities as well as the weather.

Our Arts & Crafts have included projects such as making horse treats, leather bracelets, pony picture art, T shirts and more.

The afternoon or morning activity can be anything from learning to properly groom & bathe a horse or pony to an Equine Transportation talk & demonstration. Join us to learn about breeds, markings, barn management and then have a group scavenger hunt to test your knowledge. Each day brings new fun.

What to bring

Everyone should plan to bring their lunch in a cooler and a water bottle. Water refills will be available. Your rider will need to have long pants and hard soled shoes with a heel to ride in but may wear shorts during the non-riding portion of the day. We have helmets available for riding or you may bring your own if you have one.
